



ACADEMIC MISCONDUCT



Define as Behaviour that results in, or may result in, the candidate or any other candidate gaining an unfair advantage in one or more assessment component.

COLLUSION

This is defined as supporting malpractice by another candidate, as in allowing one's work to be copied or submitted for assessment by another.

PLAGIARISM

This is defined as the representation of the ideas or work of another person as the candidate's own.

DUPLICATION OF WORK

This is defined as the presentation of the same work for different assessment components and/or diploma requirements.
